IMMIGRATION UNDERWRITING QUESTIONS

The Insurance Industry has experienced an increase in immigration related claims, particular EB-5 Program Work.

Claims often arise where a promoter of investments had previous run ins with FINRA, state or local regulatory bodies or were sued for fraud or have criminal convictions. These EB-5/Immigration related claims are an emerging claim issue and additional underwriting review is necessary.

Under EB-5, foreigners can obtain a green card when they invest \$500,000 in a new business development project occurring in the US that leads to the creation of 10 domestic jobs. For reference, visit <https://www.uscis.gov/eb-5>
